

Code of Conduct: Students / Players

It is hereby agreed that:

- i) No pupil may be in possession of intoxicating substances (this includes chemical substances, tobacco, cigarettes, alcohol and alcoholic drinks) or objectionable reading mater or material, use them at any time or give them to anybody else.
- ii) A pupil may not harm or endanger the physical well-being of any person and may not be in possession of weapons, toys or material which can cause physical injury.
- iii) School property, or anything which belongs to anyone else, may not be taken, damaged, defaced or soiled and may not be used or borrowed without appropriate permission.
- iv) With reference to the specific circumstances of an outing/excursion, a pupil must at all times adhere strictly to restrictions and/or curfews imposed on her by the tour leader in charge of the outing/excursion. Pupils must be in the sleeping venue at the exact time stipulated. Failure to do so will be truancy and will be dealt with severely.
- v) No pupil may act or behave in any way which brings the name of their school or the organising companies into disrepute.

The company will have the right to immediately cancel the tour of any individual member of the group if, during the duration of the tour, or during the organising thereof, any participant:

- i) breaks any of the above rules
- ii) misbehaves to the extent that the supplied services or organising process get interrupted
- iii) causes danger or bodily harm to anyone or damage to any property
- iv) Contravenes the laws of a country visited on the tour.
- v) Does not co-operate with the Tour Leader and/or the representative tour operator/agent that contracted with the service suppliers.
- vi) commits a crime during the tour;
- vii) persistently affects the enjoyment of the other members of the tour or the Tour Leader;

and the client will forfeit all monies already paid to the company and will be liable to pay any costs incurred to terminate the tour and/or send any or all of the tour members back to the first departure airport.

The company supplies a tour leader who has the obligation to manage the pupils. The Tour Leader is not always an employee of the company and the company is not responsible for any claims against the Tour Leader, nor any claims against the company in lieu of the actions of the Tour Leader.

The Tour Leader is herewith authorised by the undersigned to help control the participants' behavior, liaise with the service suppliers and to change the itinerary in his discretion, after consultation with Travel and Sport

The Tour Leader is not a tour guide and his role are only to coordinate/oversee the arrangements, management and supervision of the pupils and assist with crises. He has no obligation to delivery any service to and/or accepts any instruction from any tour member.

The client has the right through the normal legal channels to pursue any claims against the tour leader if the client deems it necessary.

2 LIABILITY

Neither the company nor the tour leader will be liable for any loss, injury to, or death of any of the participants or client during the tour if such damage was caused by any tour member's neglect or unlawful action. The extent of damages claimed from the company will be reduced by the amount that would reasonably have been payable by travel insurance and insurance covering service suppliers, whether such insurance is in place or not.

The undersigned undertakes to inform the Company of any possible claims against the Company in writing by means of any two of email, fax or registered letter to the Company's registered address within 14 days of becoming aware of such loss or event that can lead to a claim against the Company. The Client accepts that if the Company is not so informed within this period the Client forfeits any right to a claim and releases the Company from any responsibility for any action or event leading to a claim.
