

Code of conduct – Supporters

It is hereby agreed that:

The playing of School Sport is primarily of an educational nature.

The aim of school sport is to encourage participation and to engender in players the highest standards of sportsmanship, self-discipline and control. Parents and supporters need to support these ideals in the way in which they behave on the side lines.

- i. Positive support will be appreciated.
- ii. Parents and supporters are requested to refrain from directing negative comments at umpires, any other officials, players or opposition supporters.
- iii. Parents and supporters are asked to position themselves well clear of the side lines and refrain from standing or sitting behind the goals.
- iv. Parents are instructed to stay out of the Technical table area for the duration of the Tournament (area where players and officials are seated).
- v. In the event of an Injury, parents and supporters are not allowed on the field and must stay out of the Technical Table area. The Manager of the team will be called onto the field by the umpire and the Tournament Director/Officer will communicate with you – you have given consent to the Manager to act in 'loco parentis' for the duration of the Tournament.
- vi. Parents are not to interfere with the Coach's team selection for any game.
- vii. Parents and spectators should take up any concerns with Tournament Organisers. Please do not approach individual players, officials, umpires and coaches.
- viii. Parents not to interfere with team activities
- ix. If you would like to take your child somewhere, please make sure it does not interfere with scheduled team activities. Make this arrangement with your coach/manager
- x. No supporter may be in possession of intoxicating substances (this includes chemical substances) or objectionable reading matter or material, use them at any time or give them to anybody else.
- xi. A supporter must use no more alcohol as what would keep their blood alcohol levels within the legal alcohol blood levels as prescribed for driving in the country where he/she is.
- xii. A supporter can smoke cigarette and/ or tobacco only. No supporter can give cigarettes and/or tobacco to any school child.
- xiii. A supporter may not harm or endanger the physical well-being of any person and may not be in possession of weapons, toys or material which can cause physical injury.
- xiv. Hotel, Bus, Restaurant/Fast Food outlets, Tourist attraction property, or anything which belongs to anyone else, may not be taken, damaged, defaced or soiled and may not be used or borrowed without appropriate permission.
- xv. No supporter may act or behave in any way which brings the name of Travel and Sport or the organising companies into disrepute.

The company will have the right to immediately cancel the tour of any individual member of the group if, during the duration of the tour, or during the organising thereof, any participant:

- i) breaks any of the above rules
- ii) misbehaves to the extent that the supplied services or organising process get interrupted
- iii) causes danger or bodily harm to anyone or damage to any property
- iv) Contravenes the laws of a country visited on the tour.
- v) Does not co-operate with the Tour Leader and/or the representative tour operator/agent that contracted with the service suppliers.
- vi) commits a crime during the tour;
- vii) persistently affects the enjoyment of the other members of the tour or the Tour Leader;

and the client will forfeit all monies already paid to the company and will be liable to pay any costs incurred to terminate the tour and/or send any or all the tour members back to the first departure airport.

The company supplies a tour leader who has the obligation to manage the coaches. The Tour Leader is a representative of the company and the company may be held responsible for any claims against the Tour Leader

The Tour Leader is herewith authorised by the undersigned to help control the participants' behavior, liaise with the service suppliers and to change the itinerary in his discretion, after consultation with Travel and Sport

The Tour Leader is not a tour guide and his/her role are only to coordinate/oversee the arrangements, management and supervision of the pupils and assist with crises. He/she has no obligation to delivery any service to and/or accepts any instruction from any tour member.

The client has the right through the normal legal channels to pursue any claims against the tour leader if the client deems it necessary.

2 LIABILITY

Neither the company nor the tour leader will be liable for any loss, injury to, or death of any of the participants or client during the tour if such damage was caused by any tour member's neglect or unlawful action. The extent of damages claimed from the company will be reduced by the amount that would reasonably have been payable by travel insurance and insurance covering service suppliers, whether such insurance is in place or not.

The undersigned undertakes to inform the Company of any possible claims against the Company in writing by means of any two of email, fax or registered letter to the Company's registered address within 14 days of becoming aware of such loss or event that can lead to a claim against the Company. The Client accepts that if the Company is not so informed within this period the Client forfeits any right to a claim and releases the Company from any responsibility for any action or event leading to a claim.

The client undertakes to claim from the company only damages caused by the company's direct neglect. The client undertakes not to claim from the company any claim that can be lodged against another party.

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
