Itinerary

Day 1: South Africa - Scotland

Depart from South Africa on your flight to **Edinburgh**.

Day 2: Edinburgh

Arrive today in **beautiful Scotland**. The tour kicks off in Edinburgh. Enjoy a **guided tour** of the world famous **Edinburgh Castle**, the most besieged castle in Britain and home to the Scottish Crown Jewels. This evening enjoy a welcome dinner at a local restaurant, indulging in some local Scottish fare.

Day 3: Edinburgh

This morning, head out to the **University of Edinburgh**. Founded in 1582, it is the sixth-oldest university in the English-speaking world. Here, take a tour across the hallowed campus grounds before sitting for a **private lecture**. This afternoon is yours to explore this ancient and beautiful city at your own pace. Then get ready to see the dark side of Edinburgh, as you **meet your guide for an evening Ghost Walk!**

Day 4: Edinburgh - Durham - Leeds

Today, complete your sojourn in Scotland. Start your journey south into England, as you make your way to **Durham**, famous as a **filming location for Harry Potter**. Whilst there enjoy **guided tours of Crook Hall & Gardens, Durham Castle and the magnificent Cathedral, featuring in Harry Potter as part of Hogwarts**. Finish off by transferring to your stopover for the night in Leeds.

Day 5: Leeds - Cambridge - London

Continue your journey to the famous university town of **Cambridge**. Once there, enjoy a **guided tour of this iconic university**. Finish off with **visits to King's College Chapel and the Backs**, a picturesque area overlooking the **River Cam**. Later this afternoon, transfer south to the bustling capital, **London**. Upon arrival, check in and settle.

Day 6: London

After breakfast, depart on a **full-day guided tour** of this eternal city. Travel through the ancient streets, stopping to marvel at sites such as, amongst others, **Trafalgar Square, Buckingham Palace, Houses of Parliament and Tower Bridge**, straddling the mighty **Thames River**. After lunch (own account), head over to the London Eye and take in some spectacular views of the city as you ride one of the largest Ferris wheels in the World. Finish off by brushing shoulders with the rich and famous at **Madame Tussauds**.

Day 7: London - Oxford - London

After breakfast, transfer to the **heart of Oxford**, nestled in the breathtaking English countryside. Enjoy a morning **guided tour of Oxford**, stopping to see the main sights such as: **Bridge of Sighs and the Radcliffe Camera building**, home to the Bodleian Library.

Thereafter, visit one of the **most famous and prestigious colleges at the University of Oxford, Christ Church College**. Finish off at what is often referred to as the **spiritual heart of Oxford, the University Church of St Mary the Virgin**. Enjoy some leisure time before heading back to London.

Day 8: London

Today, kick off with a visit to **Regent's University London**. Take a campus tour before delving into a **private lecture**. *Regent's University London is renowned for its international outlook and beautiful campus set within Regent's Park*. This afternoon, visit one of London's most popular museums, **The Natural History Museum**. Finish off at **Piccadilly Circus**, in the heart of this ancient city. Enjoy the plethora of shopping options as you select a memento or two to take home to loved ones. This evening, head over to **London's West End** for a show (optional).

Day 9: London

This morning, visit **King's College London, a member of the prestigious Russell Group** (the UK's equivalent of the Ivy League) for your **final private lecture**. Select your preferred optional excursion for your afternoon activity: **Warner Bros. Studio Tour, Twickenham Stadium Guided Tour, Windsor Castle Tour or Arsenal Stadium Tour**. This evening, relax and reflect on your experiences at your **farewell dinner** at a local restaurant.

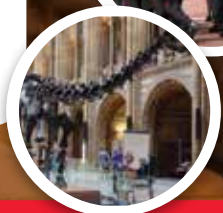
Day 10: London
